

CV 7th grade learn skills while preparing donated food

GREELEY -- Central Valley High School (CVHS) students learned knife techniques while preparing food donated to Central Valley Public Schools (CVPS).

Students taking part in Kathleen Kennedy's, CVHS Family and Consumer Science Instructor, FACS 7 class cut and cubed 100 pounds of the 400 pounds of carrots donated to the school by Esther's Table, a local non-profit organization, on Jan. 24. Those prepared carrots were then packaged and stored for later use in the Central Valley Elementary School and CVHS salad bars. Since the start of the 2017-18 school year, Esther's Table has donated fruits (i.e. apples and oranges) to CVPS. The last donation was the first time the non-profit donated a vegetable.
